Summary of 2010 Census Data



15-19 year old females who have given birth to a child.

Burdekin: total of 15 representing 6% of 15 -19 females.
Ingham: total of 6 representing 3.4% of 15 -19 females
Charters Towers: total of 11 representing 3.3% of 15-19 females
Townsville West: Total of 17 representing 6 % of 15 – 19 females.
Upper Ross: Total 27 representing 6.7% of 15-19 females
Townsville: Total 177 representing 2.6% of 15 – 19 females



Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Youth (12-24)

Burdekin: 81 representing 7.3% of Youth population
Ingham: 76 representing 9% of Youth population
Charters Towers: 256 representing 18% of Youth population
Townsville West: 433 representing 19.7% of Youth population
Upper Ross: 620 representing 18.3% of Youth population
Townsville: 3020 representing 9.6% of Youth population

Households without Internet Access



Burdekin: 837 households. 41% of Indigenous households have no access compared to 27% of Other households
Ingham: 723 households. 17% of Indigenous households have no access compared to 28% of Other households.
Charters Towers: 895 households. 48% of Indigenous households have no access compared to 29% of Other households
Townsville West: 1 467 households.37% of Indigenous households have no access compared to 25% of Other households.
Upper Ross: 1 195 households. 32% of Indigenous households have no access compared to 16% of Other households.
Townsville: 10 830 households. 29% of Indigenous households have no access compared to 17% of Other households

Youth aged 13 -17 not attending Secondary School



Burdekin: 54 representing 9% disengagement
Ingham: 38 representing 7% disengagement
Charters Towers: 111 representing 14% disengagement
Townsville West: 221 representing 22% disengagement (Garbutt was 28%)
Upper Ross: 347 representing 20% disengagement
Townsville: 1 945 representing 15% disengagement
