## GOALS

YHARS program workers focus on empowering young people by:

- 🔑 Finding safe accommodation
- 🔑 Teaching life & independent living skills
- 🔑 Engaging in education, training or employment
- 🔑 Linking them to other support services to create a long-term success plan

## YOUTH HOUSING AND REINTEGRATION SERVICE (YHARS) PROGRAM



Helping young people who are **homeless** or **at-risk of homelessness** transition into **independence** and greater **stability**.

YHARS program provide:

<b>Case management</b>	<b>Advocacy</b>	<b>Support (e.g. brokerage)</b>
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YHARS provides these services (if eligible) for:

Young people **aged 16 to 21** who are homeless or at risk of homelessness

### WHO ARE ALSO

- ➊ Transitioning from the Child Protection System
- ➋ Exiting care (17-21 yrs)
- ➌ Transitioning from a Youth Detention Centre
- ➍ Living in temporary/unstable housing

Participation is **VOLUNTARY**; a young person must be willing to engage.

Referrals accepted from:

- 🔑 Government departments
- 🔑 Non-government organisations
- 🔑 Young people (self-referral)

### After Care

Individualised support through brokerage funds for young people aged 17-21 who are receiving case management from other agencies
