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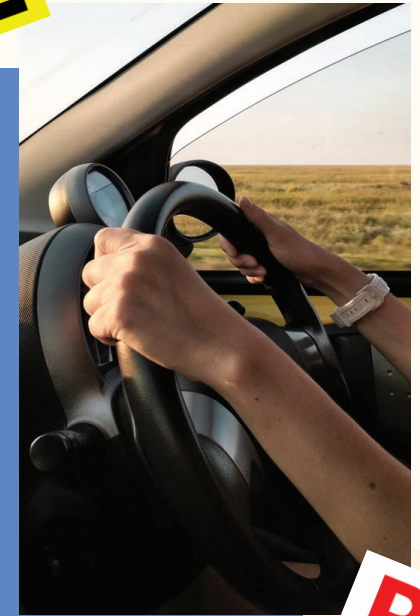

LEARNER DRIVER MENTOR PROGRAM



WHAT WE OFFER

The QYS LearnIt program assists disadvantaged young people who are unable to complete their 100 hour learner logbook requirements before being able to undertake their practical driving test to obtain their P1 provision license. Usually they have no access to a vehicle or a supervisor driver.

Our volunteer mentors will support you in gaining skills and experience on the road and building your hours to the level required to pass a P test. Gaining a P1 license will give you greater access to our community and will assist in your ability to gain employment.

ELIGIBILITY

- Hold a Queensland learners licence
- Between the ages 16-25
- Do not have access to a driving supervisor or unable to get your P's due to financial hardship

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR

- Up to three professional driving lessons
- Hours with volunteer mentors to build driving skills

- Access to regular safety sessions
- > Learn the skills and knowledge to be a safe and competent driver on our roads
- Improved time management and communication skills
- > Confidence on the road in a variety of driving situations
