## OVERVIEW

LEARNIT

The QYS LearnIt program assists disadvantaged young people between the ages of 16-25 who are unable to complete their 100 hour learner log book requirements before being able to undertake their practical driving test to obtain their P1 provision license.

This may be due to a number of different circumstances, with the main ones being that they have no access to a vehicle or driving supervisor.

LearnIt runs primarily with the support and time provided by our *Volunteer Mentors*. Without our volunteers, this program would struggle to exist leaving our communities with disadvantaged young people unable to get a license, therefore limiting their employment & social opportunities.



## ELIGIBILITY

- Held an Australian open drivers license for a minimum of one year
- Has a valid blue card. QYS will assist in obtaining this at no cost



## THE MENTORS JOB

Assist the young person in completing their 100 hour learner logbook requirements.

By assisting young people in achieving their logbook hours you are providing them with the opportunity to gain employment, further their education, ability to assist family with medical or everyday appointments as well as further freedom to participate in the community.
